Attention remodelers, multifamily owners/maintenance personnel, painters, window installers, plumbers, electricians, HVAC contactors and anyone who works in pre-1978 housing!!

New EPA regulations REQUIRES that persons performing renovation, repair, and painting projects that disturb painted surfaces in homes, child care facilities and schools built before 1978 to be certified as a lead safe contractor firm and follow specific work practices to minimize public exposure to lead hazards contained in lead paint. Individuals performing renovation and repair activities that disturb painted surfaces must be EPA certified renovators or have been trained and supervised by an EPA Lead Certified Renovator. A certified renovator must also be assigned to each renovation project undertaken by a certified firm and perform all of the EPA-mandated responsibilities and reporting of a certified renovator. Fines for violation of the EPA mandate is \$37,500 per occurrence! Any company or firm who conducts such activity must also be certified as an EPA Certified Firm and employ certified renovators to oversee the renovations.

This one-day, 8-hour, class will give you the EPA-mandated training for you and/or your employees to become Certified Renovators and comply with this new federal law.
