

## Program Description

The Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry has adopted regulations naming the 2009 International Construction Codes (ICC) as the minimum building standard for commercial and residential construction in Pennsylvania. As a result, all residential construction must now be built in compliance with the 2009 International Residential Code (IRC).

This program is intended to help builders, design professionals, remodelers, trades persons, code officials and others involved in the residential construction understand the changes contained in 2009 IRC. Participants will not only learn the differences between the 2006 and 2009 codes, but also how it impacts the way houses are designed, built and inspected.

- Residential sprinklers
- New requirement for habitable attics
- Carbon monoxide detectors
- Cast-in-place and pre-cast concrete foundations
- Deck ledger attachments requirements
- Wall construction and wall bracing
